Budget Review

Nichols – 2019 Still has some outstanding invoices. We have collected 105% of our expected revenue. Administrative expenses are at 91.3%, Operational Expenses are at 90.2% and Capital Expenses are at 25.7% with Total Expenses at 66.4% of budget. After wildland engine comes in, we should be about \$89,000 under budget.

Reports from the Chief -

Chief Hume – We had 45 calls in November.22 EMS, 23 Fire and 0 HazMat. Fleet is in good shape, working with Front Range to get annual service done, probably in about 2 weeks. The wildland workgroup is looking into delivery dates for E6. Division of Fire Prevention and Control has a driving simulator trainer that we could borrow for training. The termination in absentia letter was sent out certified mail. It has been sent back as undeliverable. The State Fire Commission has been discussing how to address the shortfall in funding with wildland calls. Lots of good conversations. The storage bays North facing door has the snow shed dumping right in front of the doors. Which is a design issue. It blocks access and drops near the gas meter. We are working on clearing that. It is a hazard. When the weather clears, we will get a proposal for a sloped cover for that. We have contracted in the past with Ager for snow removal at the tower. It was costing about \$350 a month. This year we got a bid and elected to do it ourselves instead. Nick Scheller has been clearing snow with a skid steer for the cost of fuel. We paid \$125 to provide a new cutting blade on the skid steer. Thank you to Nick. We had PR requests for the library, senior social center, and career fair all go out today.
